Specifications & Pricing Format

The product and pricing sections carry the highest evaluation weight. Present FF&E specifications in the exact format requested by the RFP, and structure pricing to demonstrate value at every volume tier. Mobica's vertically integrated manufacturing enables aggressive volume pricing that import-reliant competitors cannot match.

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ROLLOUT PLANNING

Implementation Timeline

Demonstrate that Mobica for Integrated Industries can execute a smooth, on-time FF&E rollout across multiple properties. The phased approach below leverages Mobica's 15-factory capacity to deliver parallel production streams, reducing total project duration by 30-40% vs. single-facility manufacturers.

Phased Rollout Template

1 Contract Execution & Design Kickoff (Weeks 1-3)

Finalize contract terms, assign dedicated project manager and design liaison from LIVE brand team. Conduct kickoff call with hotel procurement and interior design teams. Gather property-specific brand standards, material specifications, and finish palettes. Arrange factory visit for client design approval.

2 Prototyping & Sample Approval (Weeks 4-8)

Produce full-scale prototypes per brand specifications (finishes, fabrics, hardware). Ship prototypes to designated test property or design studio for stakeholder approval. Iterate based on feedback -- Mobica's in-house design team can modify within 5-7 business days. Final sign-off on materials, dimensions, and finishes before mass production.

3 Mass Production (Weeks 9-16)

Risk Mitigation

All shipping routes have backup logistics partners pre-contracted for Suez Canal disruptions.

As a trusted OEM supplier to IKEA, we operate 15 factories across 280,000 m², employing 2,400+ skilled workers who produce furniture meeting the world's most demanding quality standards. Our hospitality FF&E division specializes in guestroom case goods, lobby and public area furniture, F&B seating, and meeting room solutions across MENA markets. Our LIVE and WORK brand lines are purpose-built for commercial hospitality applications, and our European partnerships with Poliform, Varaschin, and Tonon extend our range into the luxury segment.

Q: How do you handle multi-property logistics and distribution?

MODEL ANSWER

Mobica operates its own logistics division with direct access to Alexandria port. We offer both FOB and DDP Incoterms, with established freight forwarding partnerships across the MENA region. For multi-property rollouts, we coordinate phased deliveries on a property-by-property schedule -- each shipment containerized, labeled by property, and documented with packing lists matched to room assignments. Our 15-factory capacity means we can produce furniture for 3-4 properties simultaneously, staggering delivery to match each property's construction or renovation timeline.

Q: What is your approach to product defects and warranty claims?

MODEL ANSWER

Our IKEA-grade QC process maintains a defect rate below 0.5%. Every production batch is photographed and documented before shipping. For warranty claims: we respond within 48 hours, dispatch a technician for on-site assessment within 1 week (MENA region), and provide replacement parts or full replacement within 2-4 weeks depending on the item. Our standard warranty covers 5 years structural, 3 years upholstery/finish, and 1 year mechanism. Root cause analysis is conducted on every claim and fed back into production improvement protocols.

Q: Why should we choose an Egyptian manufacturer over European or Chinese FF&E suppliers?

MODEL ANSWER

Mobica offers a unique combination: European-grade quality (proven by our IKEA OEM status and Poliform/Varaschin partnerships) at a 30-40% cost advantage over European manufacturers, with shorter lead times and lower freight costs than Chinese suppliers for MENA-destined projects. Our Egyptian location means 5-7 day shipping to Gulf ports vs. 25-35 days from China. Additionally, our bilingual Arabic/English team eliminates communication barriers common with Asian suppliers, and our MENA time zone alignment enables same-day resolution of production questions.
